Ludwig-Erhard-Berufskolleg is an upper secondary commercial vocational school with two departments, the main one in the city centre of Paderborn and a smaller one in Büren, which is 30 km away from Paderborn.

History of LEBK


In January 1893, business school education began with the implementation of the so-called "Sunday School".



In 1926, the school moved to the building at Schützenweg 4 where it is partially still situated today.

Towards the end of the Second World War, the lessons were stopped for almost one and a half years.

In 1978, the school was given the name of the first Minister of Economics (1949-1963) and later Chancellor of the Federal Republic of Germany (1963-1966), Prof. Dr. Ludwig Erhard.





In 1982, after the completion of the new buildings at Schützenweg and Bischofsteich, the school moved into the new classrooms.

In 1987, the partnership with the commercial vocational school "Lycée Saint-Charles Sainte-Croix" in Le Mans was established which has existed ever since.



Since 1 August 1992, the Ludwig Erhard School has had a second location in Büren.

In August 1998 the school was renamed "Ludwig-Erhard-Berufskolleg des Kreises Paderborn - Berufsfeld Wirtschaft und Verwaltung".

Due to the growing number of students and lack of room facilities, the school was split and Berufskolleg Schloß Neuhaus was established on 1 August 2000.

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- There are about 90 teachers in Paderborn and 20 in Büren, and always some teachers in training.
- There are about 1,500 students in Paderborn (500 full-time and 1,000 part-time) and about 250 students in Büren (150 full-time and 100 part-time).
- The non-teaching staff consists of two facility managers, five secretaries and three social workers.
- In Paderborn there are about 51 rooms for schoolwork.
- Courses take place in 38 classrooms.
- For physical education there are three sports halls.
- There are 13 rooms for special purposes, e. g. computer rooms with about 26 personal computers especially to be used in computer science and information technology, but also for language training.
